

**Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C**  
**Wednesday, December 2, 7:00 PM- Matters Addressed**

Minutes. The Commission voted 6-0 to adopt the minutes of its regular monthly meeting that took place on November 4, 2015.

PSA 303 Police Report. Officers from Police Service Area 303 provided an update on crime and safety in Adams Morgan.

16th Street Transit Study. The Commission voted 6-1 to make a suite of recommendations regarding the bus transit along 16<sup>th</sup> Street concerning the alternates DDOT has offered. These included supporting a peak-hour bus lane and off-board payment, and opposing removal of the V Street bus stop and truncated service for certain routes.

Scottish Rite Parking Lot: With respect to the public space elements of this proposed residential development on the Scottish Rite parking lot, the Commission voted 7-0 to call on DDOT Public Space to preserve the four public parking spaces on Mozart Place across the street from the proposed garage entrance/exit for the building.

1835 Ontario Place: The Commission voted 7-0 to appeal the issuance of building permits for this property on the basis of multiple Zoning Administrator errors, including a determination to grant a parking credit as a result of deeming a garage as a shed as well as an adjacent finished grade determination.

Starbuck's Application for Beer and Wine Restaurant License. The Commission voted 7-0 to approve a settlement agreement in connection with Starbuck's application for a beer and wine restaurant license.

Transfer of Location for Rioja Market B License: The Commission voted 6-0 to protest an application to transfer this license to sell beer and wine for off-premise consumption to 1824 Columbia Road NW on the basis of an adverse effect on peace, order, and quiet.

Waiver of New Year's Eve Restrictions. The Commission voted 5-1 to waive restrictions in settlement agreements relating to operation of alcohol-serving establishments on New Year's Eve.

Comments on Adams Morgan Vision Framework Draft: The Commission voted 6-0 to call for a 60 day extension for providing comments for the Adams Morgan Vision Framework Draft.
