## **RESOLUTION PROTESTING APPLICATION OF MAHK Meetings, LLC**

ANC 1C protests the application for transfer of Retailer's Class C Tavern license number ABRA-116881 to MAHK Meetings, LLC, and the substantial changes requested to the license on the bases that it would have an adverse impact on:

1. Real property values;
2. The peace order and quiet of the neighborhood;
3. Residential parking needs and vehicular and pedestrian safety;

And on the additional bases that it would have a substantial adverse impact on residents in the adjacent residential district, contrary to the requirement of 25-314(c), and would result in an excessive over-concentration of tavern licensees, contrary to the provisions of the Adams Morgan Moratorium Zone (AMMZ).

ANC 1C authorizes any Commissioner to act on behalf of the Commission in proceedings on this Protest.
