Minutes of August 5, 2004

A special meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C was held on Thursday, Aug. 5, 2004 at the Third District Police Headquarters. Chairman Alan Roth called the meeting to order at 6:06 p.m. Approximately 10 members of the public attended.

In attendance were Alan Roth (1C01), Nik Apostolides (1C02), Mindy Moretti (1C04), Andy Miscuk (1C05) and Josh Gibson (1C07).

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Commissioner Moretti, secretary, moved the approval of the July 7, 2004 minutes. The motion was seconded, discussed and approved by voice vote. Commissioner Gibson moved the approval the minutes from the July 19 forum. The motion was seconded, discussed and approved by voice vote.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Commissioner Apostolides, treasurer, reported that he received an extension on submission of the Third Quarter report and that he would present that report to the Commission at the Sept. 8, 2004 meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Woody Bolton, developer for the Meridian/Crescent project provided the Commission with a presentation about the project's plan to close streets and erect a construction crane to begin work on the project. Commissioner Miscuk made a motion to approve the crane construction plan for the Meridian/Crescent. The motion was seconded, discussed and approved by voice vote.

Commissioner Moretti made a motion to protest the renewal of the ABC license for five ABC establishments: Adams Mill Bar and Grill, El Rincon, Las Placitas, Mantis and Tom Tom. The motion was seconded, discussed and approved by voice vote.

Resolution to Protest Renewal of ABC Liquor Licenses for Adams Grill, El Rincon, Las Placitas, Mantis and Tom-Tom

WHEREAS, the Adams Morgan ANC (ANC 1C) has heard various concerns and complaints expressed in the community concerning the following establishments, which have applied for the renewal of their ABC liquor licenses:

*DTR, LLC T/A Adams Grill — 1813-1815 Adams Mill Rd., NW
Soloso, Inc. T/A El Rincon — 1826 Columbia Rd., NW
Las Placitas, Inc. T/A Las Placitas — 1828 Columbia Rd., NW
India 2000, LLC T/A Mantis — 1835 Columbia Rd., NW
Zinat, Inc. T/A Tom-Tom — 2333 18th St., NW*

WHEREAS, said establishments fall in the jurisdiction of the Adams Morgan ANC (ANC 1C);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that ANC 1C will protest the renewal of these licenses on the grounds of the adverse affect of these establishments on peace, order, and quiet in the neighborhood, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANC1C may withdraw any such protests upon the approval of a cooperative agreement prior to a hearing on the protest.
