Commissioner Weise made a motion that ANC 1C write a letter to the Zoning Administrator in support of the KCA’s appeal to the Zoning Administrator’s “reliance letter” to Lowe Enterprises, based on the studies that show the plans contain an excess of FAR of approximately 30,000 square feet. Further it is moved that ANC 1C will commit this matter to the Planning, Zoning and Transportation committee for further review. It was seconded, discussed and passed by voice vote.

Commissioner Shia made a motion to have a December forum on public safety on Monday or Wednesday, December 15 or 17. It was seconded, discussed and failed by voice vote.
