

Resolution in Opposition to the Small Business Parking Permit Act of 2017, B22-0125

Whereas, parking access and public space for parking are in high demand in Adams Morgan; and

Whereas, public space for commercial sections of the community provide parking for visitors and supporters of businesses; and

Whereas, residential parking supply is in such short supply that the Adams Morgan ANC supported being included in ERPP parking legislation; and

Whereas, ANC 1C recognizes the need to support balanced parking policies to support both small businesses and residents; and

Whereas, B22-0125 would provide parking on residential streets for non Ward One residents, and non-District residents; and

Whereas, B22-0125 will increase parking pressure on residential streets while at the same time discouraging employees coming to work in Adams Morgan to use public transportation;

Now be it Resolved, ANC 1C does opposes B22-0125 because it will reduce parking available to residents by allowing non residents to park in areas designated as residential parking only; and

Finally resolved, that ANC 1C urges the sponsors of B22-0125 to withdraw this legislation.
